

Kansas Junior Livestock Show Scholarship Rules

Purpose

Award outstanding Kansas Junior Livestock Show participants scholarship support for future educational endeavors.

Awards

The Kansas Junior Livestock Show reserves the right to award 8-15 scholarships annually in varying amounts from \$750 to \$2,500.

Eligibility

- * Current year Kansas Junior Livestock Show exhibitor.
- * Current high school senior with plans to enroll in a post-secondary educational program or is currently enrolled in post secondary school.
- * Have not previously received a Kansas Junior Livestock Show scholarship.
- * Not a family member of a member of the Scholarship Selection Committee.

Application Process

- * Completed online application
- * Two letters of reference. One of the reference letters must be from your County 4-H agent or your school FFA advisor. (must be attached to online form)
- * A letter from the applicant to the Selection Committee outlining future educational plans. (must be attached to online form)
- * A high school transcript plus, if applicable, a college transcript. Also include a listing of courses in which enrolled for current fall school term. (must be attached to online form)
- * All materials must be submitted by August 15, of current year

Selection Criteria

- * 4-H/FFA activities and leadership (40 points)
- * School activities and leadership (30 points)
- * Academic Information (20 points)
- * Participation in Kansas Junior Livestock Show (20 points)
- * Other activities, leadership and work experience (30 points)
- * References (20 points)
- * Career Plans (20 points)
- * Honors (20 points)

Selection and Award Process

- * Applications will be reviewed by at least a 3-person committee selected by the Executive Committee of the Kansas Junior Livestock Show.
- * The Scholarship Selection Committee has the sole responsibility and discretion for determining the eligibility and awarding of scholarships and the committee decision shall be final.

* Payment of scholarship will be made directly to 4-H/FFA members and their school upon proof of full time enrollment in a post secondary educational program and payment of tuition.

* A scholarship must be used within three years after the day it was awarded.
